*(sitting in the front yard)*

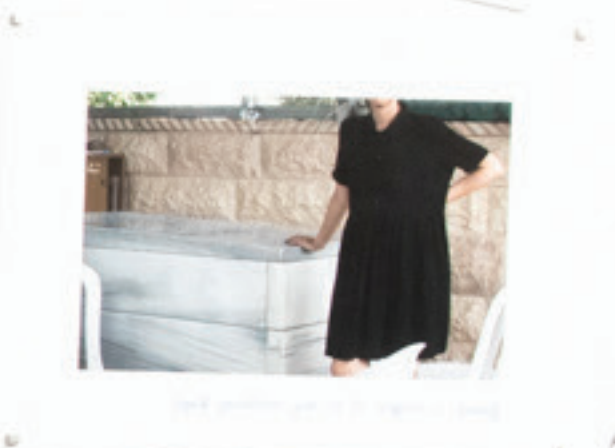
Jealous Dawud was suffering the early times in a new country. His faith weakened, he fell into the spirits.

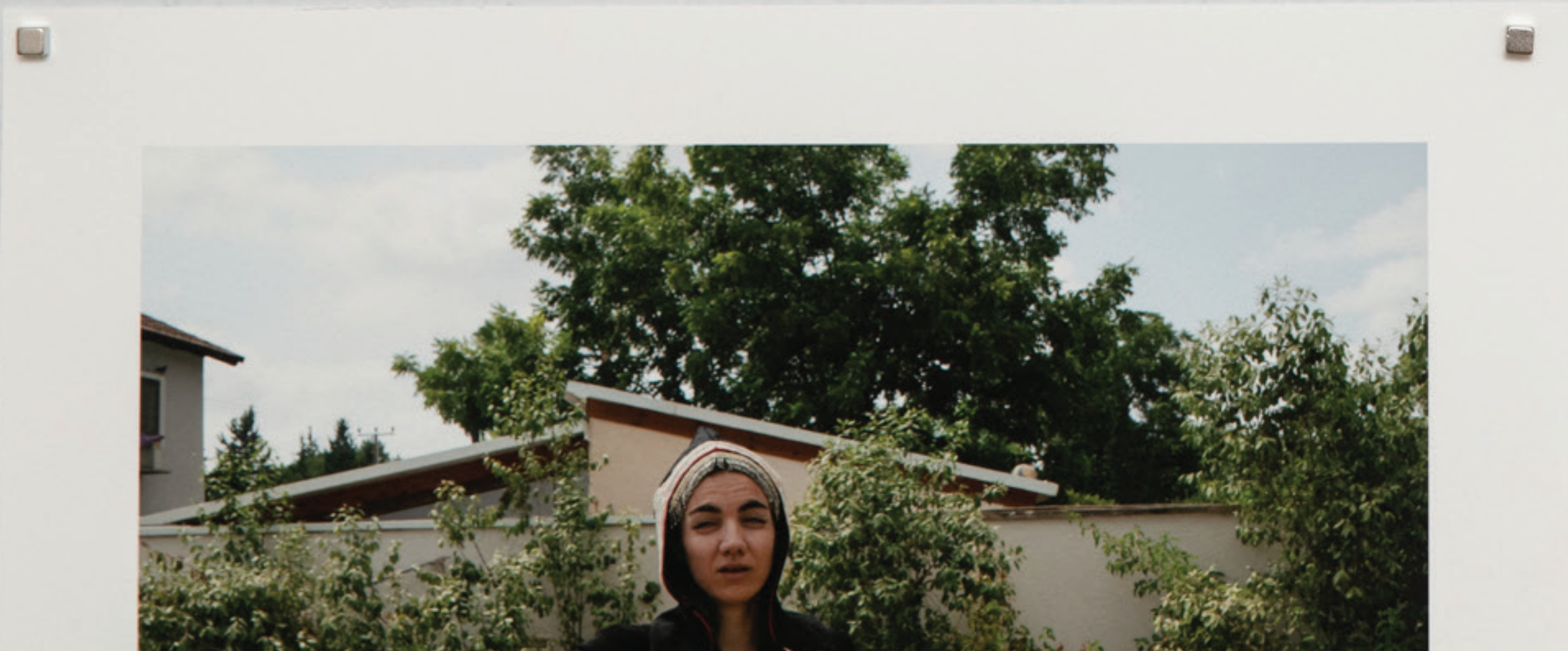

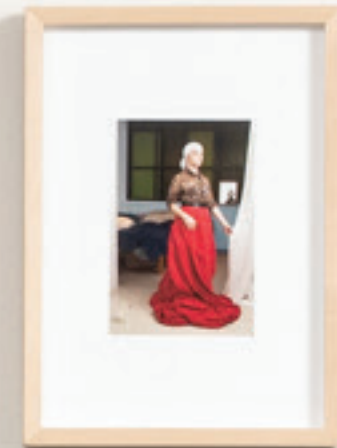

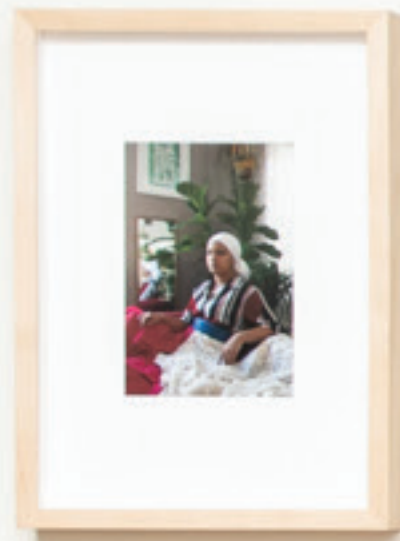
